

Communication REACH (27/06/2018)

Dear Customer,

you are aware that the third registration phase of the Regulation EC/1907/2006 (Reach) has ended on 31th May 2018 by which time all substances (“phase-in” pre-registered) manufactured or imported into the Europe in quantities:

- 1 – 100 tons/year had to be REACH registered.

Magenta Master Fibers s.r.l. would like to supply You the following updating.

- **European Suppliers of raw materials:** MMF has received the confirmation that all the substances have been registered within 31th May 2018.
- **Extra EU Suppliers of raw materials:** MMF confirms that all the substances directly imported in Europe above 1 ton/year are “phase-in”. They have been registered by MMF’s suppliers/Only Representatives within 31th May 2018.
- MMF doesn’t supply **specific information on the composition** of own Master Batches, because of they are confidential and will not report the **registration numbers** of the substances present in the Master Batches in Safety Data Sheets (SDS).
- The **exposure scenarios** will be attached to SDS only if the mixtures are dangerous.
- **“Use Descriptors”** of Master Batches:

- MMF’s Master Batches don’t contain any known amounts of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) at more than 0.1% in weight (dangerous substances that have been included in the Candidate List and in **Att. XIV** for the Authorization, issued by ECHA and updated on 27 June 2018).
- MMF’s Master Batches don’t contain any substances under restriction present in **Att. XVII**.
- **Safety Data Sheet (SDS):** because of the Derogation valid up to 31 May 2017 has decaied (mixtures supplied at least one time before 01 June 2015) according to **Regulation EC n°830/2015**, MMF will issue SDS compliant to **Att. II del Regulation 453/2010/UE**.
- **Notification:** MMF will notify to ECHA within 30 days from the date of introduction on european market, the possible importation of dangerous substance (subject to REACH or classified dangerous according to CLP) itself or present in mixtures above the specified limits in Dir. 99/45/CE or in regulation CLP.



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
